Key note speakers

Jan Pronk

Jan Pronk is a Dutch politician and was a member of the Labour Party (PvdA) until 2013. He served three terms as a Minister between 1973 and 2002. The publication of the NIOD report on Srebrenica in 2002 led to the resignation of the cabinet and Pronk as Minister. Pronk was the Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of Mission for the United Nations Mission in Sudan from 2004 until 2006.

Satko Mujagic

At age 20, Satko Mujagic survived the concentration camps Omarska and Manjaca in northern Bosnia. He currently lives in the Netherlands and works for the Immigration and Naturalization Service. In 2004 he set up the foundation OPTIMISTI that has started several reconstruction projects in his home country. Mujagic also launched a campaign to house a memorial center in the former camp of Omarska. Since 2006, the project is on hold because of protest of local politicians.
